

## 2006 Renaissance Festival Report

The 2006 Renaissance Festival ran 7 weekends this year as it usually does (this year September 2<sup>nd</sup> until October 15<sup>th</sup>). We had coverage for all weekends by the Kansas Chess Association. Income for the Renaissance Festival was \$1089.91. After expenses subtracted (-334.28) and donated income added (+65) to this, the final **NET INCOME** for the 2006 Renaissance Festival is **\$820.63**. This is \$182.73 more than in 2005, almost entirely due to increased participation by KCA members.

I (Laurence Coker) and Joe Conklin were in charge of the Renaissance Festival this year. I started scheduling the voluntary work for the Renaissance Festival beginning with the 2006 Kansas Open in July. A schedule was posted to the website. I and Joe and Spencer Conklin did booth maintenance at the beginning of the year and coverage of single days of volunteer work that were not covered by other KCA members.

As per previous years, KCA members received a full years KCA membership for working a whole weekend, whether it be a three day or a two day weekend.
