Dates: Friday, July 13, for Blitz and Bughouse, July 14 - July 15, for Open Championship **Location:** Clarion Hotel, 95th and I-35 in Lenexa, KS (same site as 2016 Kansas Open)

Room rates: \$92 (for standard King bed room, King bed with roll away, standard double bed room) \$94 (for adjoining rooms with King beds) very limited number of standard double bed rooms because of soccer event in town. Free Wi-Fi in all rooms and complimentary parking. Reservations must be made by June 1st (afterwards only on availability basis) – call 913-217-1000 to get special rate

Note: KCA Annual Meeting, which runs 8 - 9 AM. KCA membership must be current to vote.

Kansas Open 7/14 & 7/15 (Three sections)

Entry Fee: \$45 advance, must be postmarked by July 7th, \$55 thereafter, including onsite (for GM and IM entry fee see note at end of flier)

Special Advance Discount: There is an extra \$10 discount for those entering <u>both</u> the Kansas Open and the Kansas Blitz, <u>in advance</u>. Scholastic Discount: Scholastic players (K-12 students) who do NOT want to compete for cash prizes but instead play for one of two plaques in Reserve or Amateur, can enter the Reserve or Amateur sections for \$10. Scholastics can play in Open section for \$10, but there are no plaques for them in that section except for State Champion plaque (see special note, below, about arrangement with Kansas Scholastic Chess Association- KSCA- for possible free entry).

USCF & KCA membership required: KCA Membership is \$10 for family, \$7 for adults, and \$5 for juniors (18 and under). USCF and KCA memberships sold onsite. Kansas Chess Association membership required for all Kansas residents. Out of state players are welcome.

On-site Registration: 6:00-7:00pm on 7/13 or 8:30am-9:30am on 7/14

5 Round SS: 7/14 - 10:00, 2:30, 7:00; 7/15 – 9:30, 2:00 (last round could start earlier). A single, 1/2 point bye is available any round upon request, but must be requested before the start of the 2nd round.

Time Controls (for Open, Reserve, and Amateur sections): Game in 120 minutes, with 5 second delay <a href="https://doi.org/10.1001/jhan.2007/jhan.

Prizes: Prizes based on 80 total non-scholastic rate entries in three sections (Open + Reserve + Amateur)

Open Section: $1^{st} = 350 , $2^{nd} = 250 , and $3^{rd} = 150

U1900: 1st = \$120

Bonus prize of \$25 and trophy to top player from Kansas (State Champion)

Reserve Section: $1^{st} = $300, 2^{nd} = $200, 3^{rd} = 100

1599 and below: $1^{st} = 75

Bonus prize of \$25 and trophy for top player from Kansas

Amateur Section 1^{st} = \$250, 2^{nd} = \$150, 3^{rd} = \$75

1199 and below- \$50

Bonus prize of \$25 and trophy to top player from Kansas

NOTE SPECIAL ARRANGEMENTS FOR SCHOLASTIC PLAYERS WHO MUST PLAY IN STATE SCHOLASTIC TOURNEY TO QUALIFY- KSCA (scholastic) players may play in the Kansas Open this summer for free (only open or reserve, not quick or bughouse)_

To play free the player has to meet the following list of the qualifications

- 1. Play in the KSCA state tournament- March 10, 2018 in Lawrence, KS
- 2. Free entry is only for scholastic rate, may choose to play at the adult rate
- 3. Must pre-register for the event (not onsite)
- 4. Have a current USCF membership, may purchase at tournament. (Cheaper online) See USCF Membership
- 5. Must have a current KCA membership, may purchase at tournament (recommend advance purchase)
- 6. Free Entry not eligible for side events (not blitz or bughouse), may still play in those events

Kansas Blitz Chess Championship 7/13 (using Double-Round swiss G/5)

Entry Fee: \$25 advance, must be postmarked by July 7th, \$35 thereafter including onsite (see note on previous page concerning special combined <u>advanced</u> entry discount (\$10) for those playing in <u>both</u> Kansas Blitz and Kansas Open)

USCF Membership- required of all. **KCA membership-** required of all Kansas residents (both sold onsite) Other states welcome with no requirement for state membership.

Scholastic Discount: Scholastic players (K-12 students only) who do NOT want to be eligible for cash prizes and instead play for one of three plaques, the entry fee is \$10 (no free entry for scholastic players in this event)

Onsite Registration: 6-7 PM on 7/13 at Clarion Hotel main playing hall

5 rounds SS: 7, 7:30, 8, 8:30, 9 PM

Time Control: Each game in 5 minutes using highest USCF rating, be it Regular, Quick, or Blitz for pairings and for prizes (no time delay). Tourney is 5-Double-Round Swiss System, 10 games total (each round is two games, one White and one Black)

Prizes All prizes for Blitz Championship are based on 40 non-scholastic rate entries $1^{st} = 200, 2^{nd} = \$120, 3^{rd} = 80$

U2100- \$60, U1800- \$60, U1500 & unrated- \$60

Bonus Prize of \$25 and trophy to top player from Kansas (State Blitz Chess Champion)

Prize money for Blitz will not be paid until 7/14/18.

Kansas Bughouse Championship-7/13

Entry Fee: \$10 per person (\$20 total for two-player team - pay on-site)

USCF & KCA membership: are **NOT** required

Onsite Registration: 3:30 pm till 4 pm

Either 4 or 5 Round SS: Starts at 4 pm, number of rounds at discretion of tourney director

Time Control: G/5 minutes, blitz with no time delay, two games versus each team

Prizes: 75% entry fees go towards Prize fund: trophies to each member of winning team 2/3 prize money goes to first place team, 1/3 prize money goes to second place team

(7/10/18) All pay onsite now, no more early entries. We prefer cash onsite.

We will take checks but would very much prefer being paid by cash.

NOTES: Tie-breaks if necessary to determine Blitz, Open, Reserve, and Amateur champions: 1) Solkoff, (2) Cumulative, (3) Modified Median and (4) Median . <u>No Insufficient losing chances for all events at the 2017 Kansas Open</u>. Players are expected to know the rules in the <u>U.S. Chess Federation's Official Rules of Chess</u> - 6th edition and any updated rule changes since the 6th edition.

If more than 30 in a section, accelerated pairs may be use for that section.

As stated on previous page- Annual Kansas Chess Association meeting is 8 to 9 am on 7/15 in main playing area.

Last note: Free entry for International Masters and Grandmasters with entry fee taken out of any winnings. Thus, if no money won, then no money owed. If entering Blitz plus Open and \$300 won, then \$60 is taken out of \$300. If just entering Blitz \$25 can be taken out. If just entering Open, \$45 can be taken out. Free entry does not apply to Bughouse.
